



BHARAT HEAVY ELECTRICALS LIMITED ARTISANS RECRUITMENT

ADDENDUM 01/ 2025 (Ref. Advt 04/2025)

With Reference to Notification Reference - Advt. 04/2025 the following clarification is being issued regarding the clause relating to BEST Apprentice / RUNNER UP Apprentice in All India Skill Competitions:

1. The Recruitment Notification provided that candidates who have been declared as **BEST Apprentice** or **RUNNER UP Apprentice** in the **All India Skill Competitions conducted by the Directorate General of Employment & Training (DGE&T), Government of India** would be **exempted from appearing in the Computer Based Test (CBT)** and would be called directly for Skill Test, subject to fulfilling eligibility conditions.
2. On closure of the application window, it has been observed that **substantially high number of candidates** have applied under this category. This number is much higher than the probable actual awardees of the said competitions.
3. It appears that several candidates have **mistakenly applied under this category**, probably relying on apprenticeship completion certificates or local employer-issued certificates which are **not equivalent to the DGE&T national-level award**.

Now, it has become difficult to differentiate between Actual Awardees and others who have applied under this category, therefore in order to ensure fairness and provide equal opportunity, the following decision has been taken:

- **All candidates** who have applied under the *BEST Apprentice / RUNNER UP Apprentice* category will be **issued Admit Cards and shall be required to appear in the Computer Based Test (CBT)**, along with other applicants. i.e No Candidate is exempted from **Computer Based Test (CBT)**.
- After conduct of **Computer Based Test (CBT)**, those candidates who have applied under the *BEST Apprentice / RUNNER UP Apprentice* category shall be called for **Document Verification** at the respective units for ascertaining their eligibility under the aforesaid category and verified from the Central List issued by Directorate General of Employment & Training (DGE&T), Government of India.
- Those candidates who actually possess valid certificates issued by the Directorate General of Employment & Training (DGE&T), Government of India, will continue to be **exempted from CBT marks consideration**. They shall be called directly for Skill Test, subject to eligibility conditions, and preference will be given to them as per the Recruitment Notification.
- At the time of document verification, candidates who do not possess valid certificates for consideration under the BEST Apprentice / RUNNER UP Apprentice category will be treated at par with other applicants, and their shortlisting will be carried out based on their merit in the Computer Based Test, within their respective category/trade/unit.
