1	<p>I have done ITI in Electrician Trade & also done ITI in Electronics Mechanic Trade, am I eligible to apply for both the positions?</p> <p>I have done ITI in Welder Trade & also done ITI in Fitter Trade, am I eligible to apply for both the positions?</p>	<p>The requirement of BHEL position is specific as per qualification mentioned in the detailed advertisement.</p> <p>In such as case, candidate, may be eligible to apply for both the positions. However, candidates must carefully choose to apply to Manufacturing Unit of their preference, against vacancies available in their respective trades, as candidate can apply against vacancies of ONE unit & ONE trade only.</p> <p>Candidates should refrain from applying to multiple positions and different units.</p>
2	I have completed my apprenticeship and the Apprenticeship Certificate is yet to be received. Am I eligible to apply for BHEL Artisan-2025?	Candidates must be in a position to produce their ITI & NAC Certificates and marks sheets by 1 st October, 2025 or at the time of Skill Test, whichever is earlier.
3	I have studied Diploma in Electrical Engineering. Am I eligible to apply against this advertisement?	Candidates with higher qualifications or not possessing requisite qualifications as per notification are not eligible to apply.
4.	I am meeting all requirements with respect to Qualifications belonging to the General Category. However, I will be 27 years and 5 days old on 01-July-2025. Am I eligible to apply?	Candidates belonging to General category and not claiming any other age relaxation, born before 01-July-1998 are not eligible to apply. (For age relaxation candidate may refer our detailed online advertisement)
5.	I am meeting all requirements with respect to Qualifications and over age by 3 Months. However, I have 3 Months work experience certificate. Am I eligible to apply?	Age Relaxation on account of experience to candidate shall be given for minimum of 6 Months of service and up to a maximum of 7 years. (For age relaxation candidate may refer our detailed online advertisement)
6.	I am a SC/ST/OBC candidate but don't have the caste certificate, can I apply as a General candidate?	If you so desire, you may apply as General Candidate (if eligible for Gen category) giving your category as "Gen". In such an event, your candidature will be considered as "GEN" and no change in category shall be allowed at a later date.
7.	Will any Travelling Allowance be paid to me for attending the COMPUTER BASED EXAMINATION?	No Travelling Allowance is payable to the candidates for attending the COMPUTER BASED EXAMINATION. You will have to attend the COMPUTER BASED EXAMINATION at your own expense.
8.	Will any Travelling Allowance be paid to me for attending the Skill Test, as applicable?	Candidates shortlisted for Skill Test Stage shall be reimbursed second sleeper train fare as per rules. However, at this stage, if it is found that the candidate does not fulfil any of the eligibility conditions, they will neither be allowed for the Skill Test / Document Verification Stage nor paid any Travelling Allowance.
