8.	Where can I get the Question Bank?	Objection management window is opened after upto 5 Days from the Date of Computer Based Examination (CBE), wherein any candidate can view the Question Set, Answer Key and their selected options and can raise an appeal against any question. Since, this is a CBE, this information is not available post expiry of Objection Management Window, therefore interested candidates may download or retain a printout of their answer copy for their own use.

24.	Does any agency carry out selections or Interviews on behalf of BHEL ?	BHEL does all its recruitment through its own Team and CBE through its Testing partners.
25.	What is the nature of duties/roles & responsibilities/ functions of Engineer/Executive trainees or Supervisor Trainees recruited in BHEL?	Engineer/Executive Trainees or Supervisor Trainees recruited in BHEL undergo one-year training. After successful completion of training, they are posted in any of the key functions of the company based on organizational requirements.
26.	What are the directives regarding recruitment of SC/ST, OBC, PwD, EWS, Women and minorities?	Guidelines / Presidential Directives issued by the Central Govt., i.r.o SC/ST, OBC, PwD, EWS, Women and minorities are followed in the matters pertaining to recruitment in BHEL.
