EXAM PATTERN & SYLLABUS

BHEL EXAM PATTERN:

BHEL Examination for Supervisor Trainee (Finance) - 2021 positions shall be an Objective Type - Computer Based Examination of Duration - 2 Hours (i.e 120 Minutes).

The Computer Based Examination shall have 4 Sections as described in the Table below:

Section Description	Marks per Question	No. of Questions
Section-I: Question on Finance (B.Com Syllabus)	1	100
Section-II: Test on Reasoning	1	20
Section-III: General Knowledge	1	10
Section-IV: General English	1	20
Total	150 Questions	
(150 Questions x 01 marks per Question = 150 marks)		

There shall be 5 Options for Each Question and a negative marking of (1/5th of Marks) for each question. There is no separate Sectional Cut-Off. However, the merit list shall be drawn on Total marks obtained by candidate in the Computer Based Examination.

BHEL EXAM SYLLABUS (In Brief):

Section wise - Syllabus in Brief is described in the table below:

Section Description	Syllabus
Section-I: Question on Finance	All Subject Topics covered in B.Com Degree, such as Accounting & Finance, Fundamentals of Financial Management , Economics, Business Laws, Direct/Indirect Tax laws, Banking, E-Commerce & Entrepreneurship etc
Section-II: Test on Reasoning	Numerical Abilities such as Number System, decimals, fractions and relationships between numbers, Percentage. Ratio & Proportion, Square roots, Averages, Interest, Profit and Loss, Discount, Mixture and Alligation, Time and distance, Time & Work, Basic algebraic identities of School Algebra, , Factor, Heights and Distances. A.P. & G.P. Series & Reasoning abilities such as Analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, spatial orientation, problem solving, analysis, judgement, decision making, Visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship concepts, arithmetical reasoning and figural classification, arithmetic number series, non- verbal series, coding and decoding, Word Building statement conclusion, syllogistic reasoning ,puzzle, Venn Diagrams , Space Visualization , Symbolic/Number Classification, Figural Classification etc.
Section-III: General Knowledge	Everyday Science, Scientific Research, Sports, Indian Culture, Indian History, Indian national movement, World & Indian Geography, Natural resources Indian Economy Indian Polity, Indian Constitution, National & International current affairs, Environment India's Agriculture, Trade & Commerce, Basic Information technology.
Section-IV: General English	Error recognition, fill in the blanks (verbs, Preposition etc.) synonyms, antonyms spelling/detecting Mis-spelt words, idioms & phrases, one word substitution sentences structure, Sentence completion, shuffling of sentence parts, shuffling of sentences in a passage, comprehension passage
